Rep. Mann, colleagues urge EPA to end burdensome agricultural processing rule

Recently U.S. Representative Tracey Mann (KS-01), and U.S. senators Deb Fischer (R-NE) and Joni Ernst (R-IA), led 25 members in sending a letter to U.S. Environmental Protection Agency administrator Michael Regan urging him to withdraw a proposed rule impacting meat and poultry processing and rendering facilities.

On December 15, the Biden administration's Environmental Protection Agency announced a proposed rule to revise wastewater discharge standards for meat and poultry processing and rendering facilities. The proposed rule would greatly decrease the allowable levels of nitrogen and phosphorous in wastewater discharge, requiring facilities to increase treatment standards for their operation. Additionally, the EPA is proposing, for the first time, to require facilities to treat wastewater that is indirectly discharged into regulated waters.

"Given the technical complexity and high costs of wastewater treatment alterations, coupled with the massive expansion of the number of regulated

facilities, a 60-day comment period demonstrates EPA is not interested in seeking meaningful input from the regulated community," the members wrote. "This costly and technically complex proposed rule would burden hundreds of meat, poultry, and rendering facilities with unnecessary red tape. As members of Congress representing districts with meat, poultry, and rendering facilities and as members of Congress who recognize these facilities' essential role within our communities and the larger food supply chain, we urge EPA to withdraw this shortsighted proposal."

"It is irresponsible for the Biden administration to propose burdensome federal regulations like this, which diminish processing options for producers, eliminate rural jobs, and reduce product availability for consumers," said Mann.

The letter pushes against this proposed rule and advocates for EPA to fulfill its duty to work earnestly with the regulated community in any future rulemaking, ensuring that future actions do not compromise America's food system.

Those who will be affected by this rule are encouraged to express their thoughts and concerns to the EPA. There will be a public hearing hosted on March 20, and EPA will continue to accept public comments through March 25, 2024. Following the close of the public comment period, EPA will begin to review stakeholder input when drafting the final rule.

Even though cull animals often are viewed as a loss, with effective planning, these animals can be a significant source of revenue. According to the 2022 National Beef Quality Audit, over time, the industry has realized that some market cows and bulls have the potential to yield valuable primals to be fabricated and sold as retail cuts and to the restaurant trade.

Chat: Feeding silage to calves

caretakers have to use

what might be leading that individual to react differently than expected. And with feed resources, the experts

clues to understand at the Kansas State University Beef Cattle Institute recommend slowly changing feeds, especially when introducing silage.

In answering a listener's question about why calves were not willing to eat silage, the Cattle Chat podcast experts suggested fol-

lowing the cues of the cattle.

"When introducing silage, you are going to have to watch the calves closely to know when you can start increasing the amount in the diet. And with some groups, you may need to move more slowly," said K-State veterinarian Bob Larson.

One reason that calves might have an aversion to eating silage is its smell, beef cattle nutritionist Phillip Lancaster.

"Silage is a fermented feed resource, so it has a different taste and smell than calves are used to," "To Lancaster said. make the silage more palatable, producers can add silage to the top of a feed source that the calves like. That way the calves have to work through the silage to get to what they prefer to eat."

Because it is a fermented product, there can be variability in the batches, Lancaster

"If it is too wet, then it has a butyric fermentation that gives it a nasty odor that really turns cattle off on eating it," Lancaster said.

"If it is too dry, it can be moldy."


Lancaster recommends that producers take a sample of the silage and have a fermentation analysis done to make sure there is the right balance of acetic acid, lactic acid and butyric acid. He also said silage inoculates added at the time the silage is made can provide bacteria at a high enough concentration to get an

If cattle are inconsistent in their willingness to eat the silage, K-State veterinarian Brian Lubbers said it is important for producers to take and store samples as they work through the feed so when they go off feed they can pull the appropriate sample to test.

optimum fermentation.

"There are microclimates within a silage pit, and so take the samples as you are feeding so that you have a representative sample to help you figure out what is actually causing them to stop eating the silage," Lubbers said.

State groups band together to encourage candidates for local offices

Across Kansas, there are more than 6,000 locally elected positions among the 286 school districts, 625 municipalities and 105 counties. Then, there are countless more positions filled by local water boards, Extension boards and more.

Those numbers aren't lost on Brenden Wirth, the director of political affairs with the Kansas Farm Bureau, who helps to manage Engaged Kansas, a program that encourages Kansans to serve in public positions.

"The reality is that serving in public positions is necessary for a community's success," Wirth said. '

Wirth was the featured speaker during the March 1 First Friday e-Call, a monthly online series hosted by K-State Research and Extension that helps to nurture small businesses and inspire entrepreneurship in Kansas. The online discussions, which routinely host dozens of Kansas citizens from the public and private sectors. are available free each month.

Wirth said Engaged Kansas is an effort led by Kansas Farm Bureau to bring together numerous partners in the state who have resources to help residents take the next step and put their name on a ballot for public office.

He said the coalition is non-partisan and unbiased, and focuses

particularly on helping Kansans prepare to run for positions on their local school board, county commission, or city council (including mayor).

"A lot of people don't understand the role of local governments and what they do," Wirth said. "And yet, there is a lot of important decisions involved with serving on a school board and the impact it has on a community."

Wirth practices what he preaches. He's a school board member in Jewell County, helping to fill a role that is in great need across the state.

He noted that there approximately are 492,000 K-12 students in Kansas, in 286 school districts. Seven large districts make up about one-third of those students; another 36 make up another one-third; and 243 school districts make up the final onethird.

"There is no better place to engage your local community than on the local school board," Wirth said.

Even so, in a recent election cycle, nearly half of the 1,100 school board seats available statewide were uncon-

County and city elected officials also are in great need. County commissioners often make important decisions that affect thousands of people, such as improvements to infrastructure; Wirth cited a recent report from the Office of Rural Prosperity indicating that 20%

City councils, he notes, often make decisions that impact infrastructure, broadband, sewer, water, housing, daycare and more. "They're extremely important to the local economy's success and a community member's

way of life," Wirth said. Wirth also highlighted the impact of decisions made by city councils on rural economies, pointing out a study by the USDA's Economic Research Service reporting that more than 50% of total farm household income comes from a source off the farm.

"We need a successful Main Street that can provide off-farm income," Wirth said.

Through Engaged Kansas, Wirth said Kansas Farm Bureau helps Kansans learn more about how to run a campaign (the group has a series of "Campaign Schools" available throughout the state), work with media, build a social media presence, print signs that work and more.

In addition to Kansas Farm Bureau, Engaged Kansas brings together leadership skills and development from more than a dozen state partners. Learn more about resources available at https://www.engagedkansas.org.





No increase in dust explosion incidents last year; ten-year average remains unchanged

The annual summary recording nationwide grain dust explosions reported nine incidents in the United States in 2023, resulting in 12 injuries but no fatalities.

"Dust explosions are one of the most serious

hazards that can occur in the grain industry," said Kingsly Ambrose, Purdue University professor of agricultural and biological engineering and report author. "The explosions can also lead to signif-

icant financial and personal losses from downtime, repair, injuries and fatalities.' Last year's nine in-

cidents marked no increase from the nine reported incidents in 2022. The ten-year average of 8.4 explosions remains relatively unchanged. Notably, this average is significantly lower than the average number of incidents that occurred prior to the implementation of the Occupational Safety and Health Administration's grain handling standard in 1988.

Ambrose said all the

the Midwest, most of them taking place in the corn handling or processing industry.

The explosions occurred in one ethanol plant, one wheat mill, two grain elevators, two soybean processing plants, two corn processing plants and one corncob processing plant. The probable ignition sources were identified in two cases as fire and another as equipment malfunction, while six cases

were from unknown sources. Fuel sources for all nine of the explosions were identified as grain dust.

The dust explosions occurred in four different states, with three each in Illinois and Minnesota, two in Iowa, and one in Indiana.

"There is a critical need to educate the workers and employers on dust explosion prevention within a facility, including assessments of dust accumulation and dust explosion protection methods," Ambrose said.

He further stressed the need to develop relevant and practical hands-on educational materials to raise awareness and adoption of prevention technologies by grain handling and processing facilities.

Purdue has been involved in collecting data related to grain dust explosions in the U.S. since 2015.







Kochia requires early,

K-State Research and **Extension news service**

Kochia, an annual weed, requires a mix of herbicides early in the year to prevent it from disturbing crop production, said Kansas State University weed scientist Jeremie Kouame.

"Now is the time to finalize plans for kochia control for the upcoming growing season," Kouame said. "In western Kansas, kochia emerges very early. In February, for example, it started emerging, and so those first flushes of weeds are going to use the moisture of the soil, which can be detrimental to crops.'

Kouame urges producers to apply a combination of pre-emergence pesticides to restrict initial kochia growth.

"If we want to achieve a good yield, we need controlled. The options that work well for kochia are a tank mix of dicamba and atrazine,' he said.

Kochia control protocols call for yearly treatment, according to Kouame.

"If last year someone had a problem and the plants were not well controlled and they allowed them to produce new seeds, then those seeds are going to come as seedlings this year and will be detrimental during the growing season," he said.

Monitoring fields consistently for a kochia appearance serves as a crucial first step in battling the troublesome weed

"One of the best weed management tools we have are our footprints in the field. Whether that's an actual farmer or whether that's their

agronomists or a crop consultant that they've hired on, boots in the field cannot be replaced, although drones are also a useful tool," K-State weed specialist Sarah Lancaster said.

Additionally, Lancaster advises farmers to stay vigilant for herbicide-resistant kochia.

"Even though most of our farmers are doing a really good job of putting these products out there in combination, I've still spent a lot of time this winter having folks be on the lookout for signs of Group 14 resistance," she said.

Kouame noted that a recent multi-state, crop study indicates great success in treating unaffected kochia in cer-

tain plant types.

"The result of this research showed that the herbicide program used for corn controlled 99% of glyphosate-resistant Kochia," Kouame said. The herbicide pro-

gram used in the study utilized Degree Xtra followed by Impact, Verdict followed by Status, and Balance Flexx followed by Laudis plus AAtrex.

"We know from the literature that these herbicides tend to synergize," Kouame said. "When they are mixed, their efficacy increases, so we can achieve better control of weeds."

Lancaster proposes another herbicide, Verdict, for remedying kochia invading sorghum

"Verdict is a combination of dimethenamid-p and saflufenacil. So, as we think about programs ahead of grain sorghum, Verdict can really play an important role there because it's going to give us some residual activity, as well as some burn-

kochia and pigweeds,' she said.


