Kansas Hay Market Report

Compared to the last report, demand slow to moderate for all hav and prices were mostly steady for all regions. It was mostly an unremarkable week with folks trying to work the fields in windy conditions. According to the U.S. Drought Monitor for March 19th, some increases in the coverage of abnormal dryness (D0) were noted on the Plains from central and southwestern Kansas northward into parts of South Dakota. Despite the Plains' pockets of dryness and drought, prospects for the winter wheat crop

remained mostly favorable. In Kansas, 55% of the winter wheat was rated in good to excellent condition on March 17, with only 12% of the crop rated very poor to poor, according to the U.S. Department of Agriculture. The categorical percent area for abnormally dry conditions (D0) increased to 40%, moderate drought (D1) decreased to near 24%, severe drought (D2)remained just under 2%, and no extreme drought (D3)or exceptional drought (D4) was recorded.

CoverCress in state's cropping systems to be discussed at April 9 KSU talk

The vice president of research at a Midwestern company aiming to develop a common weed into valuable biofuel feedstock will be speaking at Kansas State University on

Ratan Chopra's talk Sciences Center.

Chopra leads product design for St. Louis-based CoverCress, Inc., formed in 2013 to develop field pennycress as a climate-smart agriculture product that contributes to the reduction of greenhouse gas emissions through carbon seques-

America. Many farmers consider it a nuisance weed, but field pennycress is oil-rich - making it an ideal candidate for such select uses as healthy edible oils, biodegradable plastic packaging materials, lubricants and biofuels

"There is great investment and anticipation surrounding the renewable diesel economy across the U.S., and as a result, there is a significant new demand being placed on approved oilseed feedstocks," said Mike Stamm, a K-State canola breeder and chair of the Elmer G. Heyne lecture committee.

Stamm noted that the United States' current renewable diesel production capacity exceeds 4 billion gallons, but estimates indicate that will increase to nearly 6 billion gallons by 2025.

CoverCressThus. is being studied as a potential oilseed feedstock that can be grown in Kansas cropping systems. For example,

has been successfully integrated into traditional corn-soybean rotations in the Midwest.

Chopra's talk will discuss his company's progress in developing CoverCress, as well as the breeding and genomic tools used in that process. The lecture is free and open to the public.

Elmer Heyne joined K-State's Department of Agronomy in 1938, embarking on a career marked by numerous scientific achievements that improved wheat quality, resistance to disease and various plant breeding techniques. During his tenure, he released three corn lines, four sorghum lines, one barley variety, six oat varieties and ten wheat varieties.

"Dr. Heyne was a wheat breeding pioneer in his time," Stamm said, "so this topic is fitting for a lecture that commemorates his many accomplishments."

Spring forward horse health with vaccinations

Consulting Veterinarian "Healthy as a horse" starts with spring vaccinations. As horses are exposed daily to the environment, wildlife and mosquitoes that transmit the five core equine diseases, it's important to follow the American Association of Equine Practitioners (AAEP) core equine disease vaccination protocol. Make sure horses are vaccinated yearly against Eastern and Western equine encephalomyelitis, West Nile virus, rabies, and tetanus.

The American Veterinary Medical Association (AVMA) defines core vaccinations as those "that protect from diseases that are endemic to a region, those with potential public health significance, required by law, virulent/ highly infectious, and/ or those posing a risk of severe disease." Vaccinations are the foundation of your horse's preventive health program, accompanied by deworming of course, which as a general best practice adult horses should be dewormed twice yearly – during spring and fall. Vaccinating horses during the spring helps to safeguard them ahead of peak activity from carriers of such diseases, like mosquito-transmitted diseases threatening horses with mortality rates up to 90%.

The three big equine diseases transmitted by mosquitoes are West Nile virus, Eastern equine encephalomyelitis, and Western equine encephalomyelitis. Venezuelan equine encephalomyelitis isn't typically a problem in the United States, but there have been years with outbreaks in specific areas. These diseases can attack and inflame a horse's nervous system.

is important for your horse to be protected, so let's look at the basics of vaccinating horses.

Vaccine selection Every horse should receive the five core vaccinations, Eastern and Western equine encephalomyelitis, West Nile virus, rabies, and tetanus, a minimum of once per year. Additionally, horses with compromised immune systems (systemic disor those in high-risk the horse be held by areas (long mosquito vector seasons) might benefit from twice-yearly vaccination.

In addition to the core vaccines, there are risk-based vaccinations available. There are several available, but the most common riskbased vaccinations protect against rhino, influenza, strangles, and Potomac horse fever. It might seem obvious, but determining whether your horse should receive these vaccines depends entirely on their risk of exposure. For example, Potomac horse fever occurs most commonly in certain geographic areas, so if vour horse resides in a historically endemic location, then they should be vaccinated. Similarly, rhino, influenza and strangles are all respiratory illnesses that are spread by exposure to other horses or fomites contaminated by other horses. If your horse never leaves your farm and isn't exposed to horses outside of your farm, then they may not need protection against these diseases. If you regularly travel, send your horse to a trainer, go on trail rides or board your horse, then your horse would benefit from vaccination. If you have any questions in deciding whether your horse would benefit from any risk-based vaccines, your veterinarian would be a great resource.

Storage – It's important to read and follow the vaccine's label for proper storage and handling for the vaccines you select for your horse. In general, however, vaccines should be stored at a temperature of 35 to 45 degrees F and never frozen.

"Vaccina-AAEP's tion Guidelines" and "Vaccine Storage and Handling" serve as an excellent resource for horse owners. In the Guidelines, they offer great tips well worth mentioning here, including:

Monitor vaccine fridge tempera-

Keep vaccines in the middle of the refrigerator for temperature consistency, not in the door or far back

Organize vaccines according to expiration date

Where to stand -When we are administering injections, I alrecommend

a handler and not tied up. You want your handler standing on the same side as you, so if the horse jumps off to the side, both you and the handler are safe.

Needle size - When we're talking about needle selection for intramuscular injections - depending on the thickness of the medication or vaccine that we're administering we typically use an 18-to-20-gauge, 1.5-inch needle.

Injection site - For injections, my preferred site is going to be the neck, and we want to stay within that injection triangle which is in front of the shoulder blade, above vertebra column and below the nuchal ligament. If the injection site is dirty, we want to make sure to brush and clean that off before we administer the injection. We don't need to use alcohol or disinfectant over the injection site before we administer the vaccine.

mend that you remove the needle from the syringe before you administer it and using your hands, kind of desensitize the area within the injection triangle with some vigorous rubbing, scratching and tapping. You'll want to have the needle in your hands when you're doing that so with one swift motion, you can poke the horse as a practice run. After you have desensitized the area following the steps above, you can attach your syringe to it and administer the injection in the same area. Another trick is that if you don't want to remove the needle, to desensitize the area you can pinch some skin to help distract the horse and administer the injection.

Safety – Vaccines go through rigorous testing for safety before being brought to the market and they serve as an important precaution against disease risks. After receiving a vaccine intramuscu-

like to get poked, so larly, it is possible for sometimes I'll recomsome horses to demonstrate lethargy, fever, swelling and soreness in reaction to the vaccine (much like people). The reactions that horses develop to a vaccine are due to the horse's immune system responding to the vaccine. They are generally mild, self-limiting and often don't require treatment. Forcing exercise for 20 to 30 minutes twice daily for three days after vaccination will help to minimize muscle soreness. If your horse has a severe reaction, such as severe lethargy, hives or abscess formation, vou should contact vour veterinarian immediately. Horse owners can submit vaccine reactions to vaccine manufacturers, too.

Keep these thoughts

in mind as you shield your horse from disease risks. Visit ValleyVet. com to continue learning about horse health.



U.S. farmers expect to plant less corn and more soybean acres

the United States intend to plant 90.0 million acres of corn in 2024, down 5% from last year, according to the Prospective Plantings report released by USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service (NASS).

Planted acreage in-

tentions for corn are down or unchanged in 38 of the 48 estimating states. Acreage decreases of 300,000 acres or more from last year are expected in Illinois, Indiana, Iowa, Minnesota, Missouri, Ohio, South Dakota, and Texas. If realized,

corn in Arizona and Or- Louisiana, Michigan, egon will be the largest on record.

Soybean growers intend to plant 86.5 million acres in 2024, up 3% from last year. Acreage increases from last year of 100,000 or more are expected in Arkansas, Illinois, Indiana, Iowa, Kentucky, Minnesota, Missouri, North Dakota, Ohio, and South Dakota. Record high acreage is expected in Kentucky and New York.

The Prospective Plantings report provides the first official, survey-based estimates of U.S. farmers' 2024 planting intentions. NASS's acreage estimates are based on surveys conducted during the first two weeks of March from a sample of nearly 72,000 farm operators across the nation. Other key findings in the report are:

wheat planted area for 2024 is estimated at 47.5 million acres, down 4% for comparable states from 2023.

Winter wheat planted area, at 34.1 million acres, is down 1% from the previous estimate and down 7% from last year for comparable states.

Area planted to other spring wheat for 2024 is expected to total 11.3 million acres. up 1% from 2023.

Durum wheat planted is expected to total 2.03 million acres for 2024, up 22% from last year for comparable states.

All cotton planted area for 2024 is expected to total 10.7 million acres, 4% above

NASS also released the quarterly Grain Stocks report to provide estimates of onand off-farm farm stocks as of March 1. Key findings in that report include:


Corn stocks totaled 8.35 billion bushels, up 13% from the same time last year. Onfarm corn stocks were up 24% from a vear ago. while off-farm stocks were down 1%

Soybeans stored totaled 1.85 billion bushels, up 9% from March 1, 2023. Onfarm soybean stocks were up 24% from a year ago, while off-farm stocks were down 3%.


All stored totaled 1.09 billion bushels, up 16% from a year ago. Onfarm all wheat stocks were up 20% from last year, while off-farm stocks were up 14%.

Durum wheat stored totaled 36.6 million bushels, up 2% from March 1, 2023. On-farm Durum stocks were up 10% from a year ago, while off-farm stocks of Durum wheat were down 5%.
